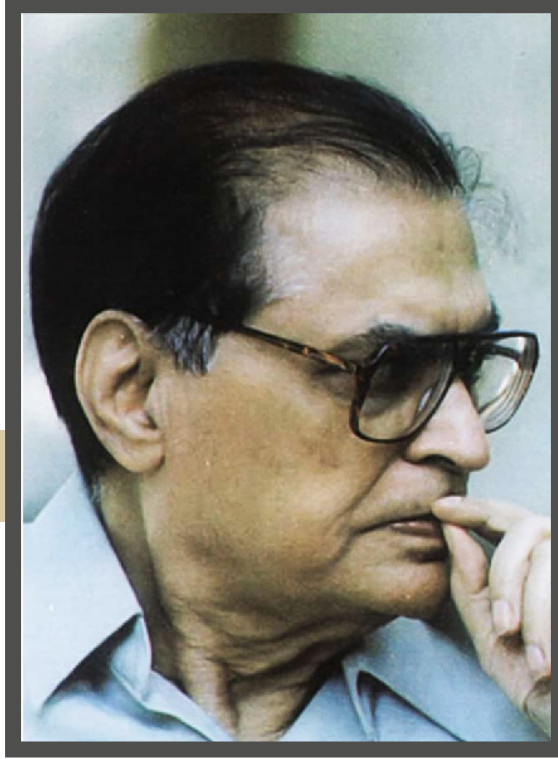

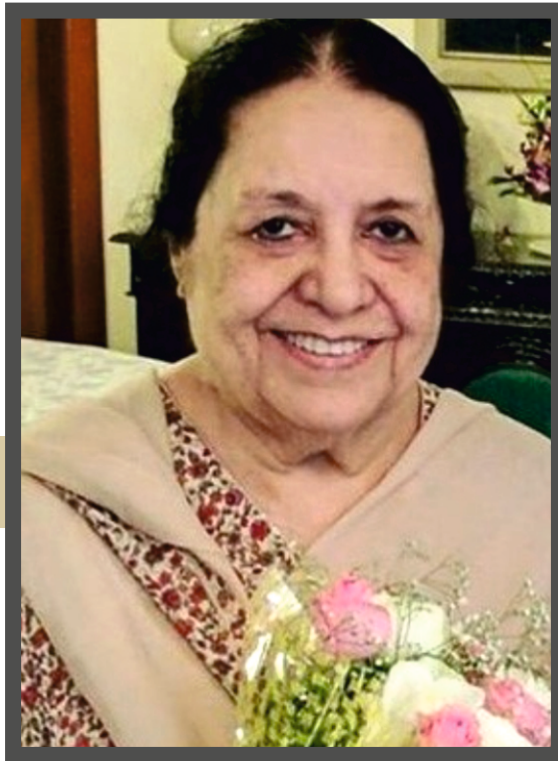

Dr. Rafiq Zakaria and Fatema Rafiq Zakaria stands for the mission and zeal for the upliftment of Aurangabad's Muslim Community. Dr. Sahab was not only a celebrated politician but a visionary who brought industries and founded number of schools and colleges in Aurangabad. He was a Konkani Muslim from Maharashtra who Practiced law in Mumbai, he spent over 25 years in public service. He contested the first election of the newly created Maharashtra state in 1962 from Aurangabad. It was he who initiated the planning of new Aurangabad hence he is accurately called as the “Architect of New Aurangabad.”

Padma Shri Mrs. Fatma Rafiq Zakaria was born Fatma Yusuf Adul Sattar in a respectable and prestigious Memon family in 1936 in Deolali. She spent her childhood and was educated at Deolali Mission School. The family shifted to Mumbai and own a large part of real state along the Grand Central Station. Since her early days she developed a passion for social services and a desire to mitigate the economic and hygienic conditions of poor and destitute. She took education and social services at the Nirmala Niketan College of social work and later shifted to Isabella Thoburn College in Lucknow. At a very young age she had to return to Mumbai to look after estate as her elder brothers and sisters were graduating from different colleges. She set up a social services unit, Phulwari and helped children from poor families, a passion that she kept alive for the rest of her life. She joined the Times of India group under tutelage of Late Khushwant Singh and R.K Laxman and rose the position of its senior assistant editor. While at the Times group she interviewed Indira Gandhi Margaret Thatcher, R.J.D. Tata, Morarji Desai and so on. After leaving the Times group she joined as a chief editor of Taj Magazine, a magazine representing world class sophistication in classical hospitality.

Nearly five decades ago, Dr. Rafiq Zakaria, the renowned scholar, statesman and senator, a giant transformational leader in the field of Education founded the Campus in Rauza Bagh to bring forth a bouquet of Institutions as diverse as Arts, Science & Commerce to Journalism, Education, Pharmacy, Information Technology, Management Studies and Hotel Management with Culinary Arts. This historic Campus was blessed with a new lease of life as our Founder President and Chairman made the most significant contribution to the macro-development of this industrial and tourist center in India, for which he is rightfully known as the "Architect of new Aurangabad". Dr. Saheb's primary focus was on the delivery of education and improvement of life for the less privileged sections of society.

Mrs. Fatma Rafiq Zakaria, the then President and Chairman of the Maulana Azad Education Society and Trust respectively, worked alongside Dr. Zakaria and paid special developmental attention to the empowerment and education of women while she created the world class Dr. Rafiq Zakaria Campus, named after our beloved leader. Dr. Rafiq Zakaria's vision for quality and excellence in Education has achieved fruition and has gained worldwide renown on account of the tireless efforts of Mrs. Fatma Rafiq Zakaria, who has been awarded the Padma Shree by the President of India for her contribution to Education.

In 1975, Dr. Rafiq Zakaria College for Women with a strength of 100 students, was shifted to the beautiful, historic Nizam's Palace known as Navkhanda Palace. Apart from the Arts stream, Science was introduced at the HSC level and also at the degree level. Realizing the need for women's' education and their empowerment, Mrs. Fatma Zakaria converted the area into a women's campus and called it Dr. Rafiq Zakaria Campus II. On the occasion of the third death anniversary of Dr. Rafiq Zakaria on July 9, 2008, Aurangabad College for Women was renamed Dr. Rafiq Zakaria College for Women in fond memory of and reverence for the mission that our Founder Chairman set out to realize and the enormous efforts that he undertook for the progress of the people of Aurangabad. The beautiful Campus houses four institutions, namely Rose Academy for Toddlers, Model High School, Dr. Rafiq Zakaria College for Women and Model D.Ed College.

Some short term professional and vocational courses with a focus on advancing careers for women were introduced. Special coaching for Junior College Arts students is also imparted by an experienced faculty. Year after year, students educated here has secured positions of merit in the Board and University examinations and also in the field of sports. The College received A grade in academic audit. Dr. Rafiq Zakaria College for women also have post-graduation in Urdu English Political Science and Chemistry. In the year 2021 College became one of the recognized research centers of Dr. Baba Saheb Ambedkar Marathwada university, Aurangabad in the subjects-Urdu English Political Science Botany Chemistry Zoology and Physics. More than 15 Colleges are associated with the Research center.

History of Navkhanda Palace.

History of Navkhanda Palace

Malik Ambar the founder of Aurangabad city (1610 A.D.) defeated Mughal emperor Jahangir and constructed victory gate “Bhadkal Gate” in 1616 A.D. It was the first column structure in Maharashtra. The massive portal gateway leading to this, over which the “Naubat Khana” sounded, was called Bhadkal. In front of Bhadkal Gate he constructed “Chhoti Bhadkal” Gate. He built “Navkhanda Palace”. ‘Nav’ means nine and ‘Khanda’ a Marathi language word, means parts. It was spread in 25 acres and 23 gunthe. In 1653 when Prince Aurangzeb was appointed the viceroy of the Deccan for the second time, he made Fatehnagar his capital and called it Aurangabad. Aurangabad is sometimes referred to as Khujista Bunyad by the Chroniclers of Aurangzeb's reign.

The Navkhanda palace which is renowned for its brilliant architecture was classified into nine apartments, the interior buildings consisted of five Zanan khana, a Divan-i-Aam (House of Commons), a Divan-i-Khaas (House of Lords), a Masjid and a Kacheri / Baradari (Today College Reading room), each provided with a garden and a cistern. The walls of the central part of the Devan khana, and a hamam or hot bath attached to the building, are in a fair state of preservation. However, the wood-work and the stucco plaster are all gone. The Divan i Aam is a large quadrangular structure, now mostly in ruins. The Kacheri and mosque is in good condition close by. The “Gadi of the Nizam”, is situated in the vicinity. The original paraphernalia are placed in the throne room.

According to one account, a noble of Aurangzeb's court named Alam Khan, made additions to this Palace; and further additions were subsequently made by Asaf Jah I. An adjoining block of buildings was screened off by a partition wall for Nasir Jang, the son of Nizamul Mulk 1st. The Navkhanda palace was also occupied by Nizam Ali Khan - Asaf Jah II, when he was at Aurangabad.

The Architect of Modern Aurangabad city Dr. Rafiq Zakaria, the great Scholar, Writer, Politician and educationist started College, exclusively for girls in Navkhanda palace (Oct. 1975). His aim was to spread education among the girls, make them Self-sufficient, Confident and Good citizens. Today this College is identified as Dr. Rafiq Zakaria College for Women, Navkhanda Palace, Aurangabad, Maharashtra, India.

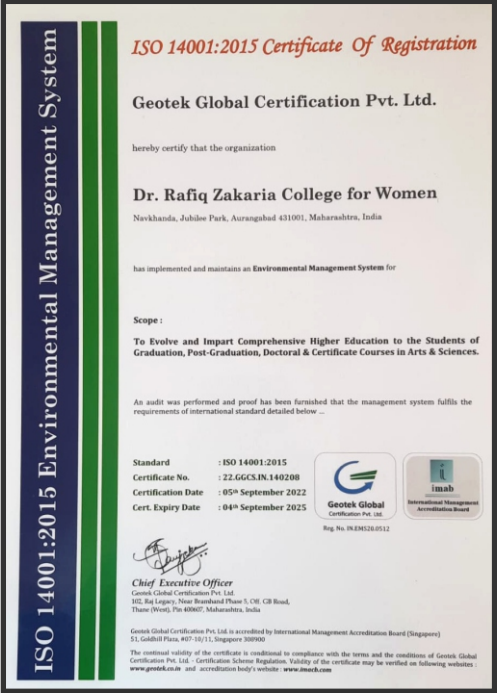
