NIRMALYA COLLECTION AND COMPOSTING

On the 14th August, 2023, the Green Club of Dr. Rafiq Zakaria College for Women, Navkhanda, Chh. Sambhajinagar Aurangabad, successfully organized a Nirmalaya Collection and Composting drive as part of its environmental awareness initiatives activity of Green club. The primary objective of the event was to promote sustainable practices by collecting floral waste and converting it into compost for use in the college's garden.

The event was timed to coincide with the conclusion of the Ganesh Chaturthi festival, a period during which significant amounts of floral waste (Nirmalaya) accumulate. Recognizing the environmental impact of this waste, the Green Club spearheaded a campaign to encourage students, staff, and the local community to contribute their Nirmalaya offerings for composting rather than disposing of them in water bodies or waste dumps.

Objectives

- 1. Waste Management: To prevent floral offerings from polluting water bodies or landfills.
- 2. Sustainability: To utilize Nirmalaya for composting, thus promoting eco-friendly gardening practices.
- 3. Awareness: To educate students and the community on sustainable waste management and composting techniques.

Nirmalaya Collection Process: The collection drive was set up at designated points within the college premises, encouraging students and faculty to bring in the floral waste. The students of the Green Club actively participated in spreading awareness about the drive and the significance of composting.

Composting Process: After the collection, the floral waste was transferred to the college's composting facility. The process included the following steps:

- 1. Sorting: The students sorted the collected Nirmalaya to remove non-compostable items.
- 2. Layering: The sorted waste was then layered with dry leaves, organic waste, and soil in compost bins.

3. Maintenance: The composting piles were watered and aerated periodically to ensure proper decomposition.

The drive successfully collected over 150 kg of Nirmalaya. The compost produced from this initiative will be used to fertilize the plants in the college's garden, reducing the need for chemical fertilizers. Students and faculty gained hands-on experience with composting techniques, and the event sparked interest in future green initiatives. There are also discussions on collaborating with local communities to replicate this model outside the campus.

Conclusion: The Nirmalaya Collection and Composting drive was a significant step towards creating a sustainable and environmentally conscious campus. The participation and enthusiasm shown by the college community highlight the potential for ongoing green initiatives that can contribute to a cleaner and greener environment.

The department of physics is well equipped with two spacious labs for college students. Most of the instruments and apparatus required for demonstrations and practical are available in the department. Apart from academics, the department enthusiastically plans and executes different curricular and co-curricular activities for the overall development of the students. Various events like seminars, poster presentation, quiz competition, guest lecture, departmental level workshop, educational tours are arranged for the students.

The department of physics works on solar energy. The Novel method is adopted for the use of solar energy. We do not convert the solar DC to AC, but we use direct 12 Volt DC output of solar panel because our most of the instruments work on DC supply and as per requirement we convert it to 6v,5v or 3 v supply.

Another special feature of the department is that our students assemble the LED bulbs they can repair it. We are having the add on course on LED bulb assembling.

Apart from this we are having different add on courses like Domestic electric wiring system, Home appliances repairing course etc.

Eminent speakers and experts in the subject are invited to deliver their lectures. With the aim of building up confidence and erase the phobia of presentation, poster presentations on various day to day activities involving laws and principles of physics are organized. Faculties from another department and collages are invited to judge the presentations.

Department has library facility with 200 different books. There is special arrangements for remedial classes, slow learner and advance learner.

Another activity of the department is the seminars by the third year students. Topic of interest is chosen and power point presentations are given. Based on their over all excellence, style of presentation I, II and III positions short listed. Efforts taken by the students are appreciated by distributing certificates to them. The

NIRMALYA COLLECTION AND COMPOSTING

On the 14th August, 2023, the Green Club of Dr. Rafiq Zakaria College for Women, Navkhanda, Chh. Sambhajinagar Aurangabad, successfully organized a Nirmalaya Collection and Composting drive as part of its environmental awareness initiatives activity of Green club. The primary objective of the event was to promote sustainable practices by collecting floral waste and converting it into compost for use in the college's garden.

The event was timed to coincide with the conclusion of the Ganesh Chaturthi festival, a period during which significant amounts of floral waste (Nirmalaya) accumulate. Recognizing the environmental impact of this waste, the Green Club spearheaded a campaign to encourage students, staff, and the local community to contribute their Nirmalaya offerings for composting rather than disposing of them in water bodies or waste dumps.

Objectives

- 1. Waste Management: To prevent floral offerings from polluting water bodies or landfills.
- 2. Sustainability: To utilize Nirmalaya for composting, thus promoting eco-friendly gardening practices.
- 3. Awareness: To educate students and the community on sustainable waste management and composting techniques.

Nirmalaya Collection Process: The collection drive was set up at designated points within the college premises, encouraging students and faculty to bring in the floral waste. The students of the Green Club actively participated in spreading awareness about the drive and the significance of composting.

Composting Process: After the collection, the floral waste was transferred to the college's composting facility. The process included the following steps:

- 1. Sorting: The students sorted the collected Nirmalaya to remove non-compostable items.
- 2. Layering: The sorted waste was then layered with dry leaves, organic waste, and soil in compost bins.

3. Maintenance: The composting piles were watered and aerated periodically to ensure proper decomposition.

The drive successfully collected over 150 kg of Nirmalaya. The compost produced from this initiative will be used to fertilize the plants in the college's garden, reducing the need for chemical fertilizers. Students and faculty gained hands-on experience with composting techniques, and the event sparked interest in future green initiatives. There are also discussions on collaborating with local communities to replicate this model outside the campus.

Conclusion: The Nirmalaya Collection and Composting drive was a significant step towards creating a sustainable and environmentally conscious campus. The participation and enthusiasm shown by the college community highlight the potential for ongoing green initiatives that can contribute to a cleaner and greener environment.

 more effectively. Do you tend to withdraw socially, become aggressive, or
 freeze up? Recognizing your patterns can help you develop healthier
 responses.
- After assessing and identifying, you can apply various strategies to manage and reduce stress:
- Time Management: Often, poor time management can lead to stress.
 Techniques like prioritizing tasks, setting goals, and breaking projects into smaller steps can help manage time more effectively.
